STATE OF NEW HAMPSHIRE

AN ACT relative to policies that municipalities are preempted from enacting.

Be it Enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court convened:

- 1 New Section; Preemption; Firearms, Abortion and Open Containers of Alcohol in Public. Amend RSA 31 by inserting after section 39-e the following new section:
- 31:39-f Preemption; Firearms, Abortion, Religion and Open Containers of Alcohol in Public. No municipality shall enact any ordinance, bylaw, rule, or other regulatory provision that applies to:
- (a) Firearms as defined in RSA 173-B:1, XI.
- (b) Abortions as defined in RSA 132:32, I.
- (c) Religion, religious practices, or places of worship, unless the regulatory provision equally applies to non-religious activities.
- (d) Alcohol as defined in RSA 175:1, III in open containers in public.
- 2 Effective Date. This act shall take effect 60 days after its passage.
